As an FYI to the weekend of reciprocity with Maine and Vermont the last weekend in January (27-29th), it was brought to everyone's attention at the last county meeting that **VT requires that all snowmobile operators born after 1983 must carry a certificate showing completion of a snowmobile safety course.** This is required even if you carry a valid driver's license! The safety course can be taken online and you'll receive a certificate upon completion. You can find the information regarding this at this website:

Vermont also requires that you have proof of insurance on your sled with you at all times.

Be sure to do a safety check of your sleds and get them registered so that once the trails open, you are ready to ride! It's no fun to break down on the trail and have to get towed back!
